## **Methods**

Transversal descriptive study.

Pre-established questionnaire.

Inclusion criteria: Patients of all ages who consulted on the day of the event at Ksar Bouderhem primary School.

Team: doctors, paramedics, and scientists.

Media coverage: Social networks, regional radio, and posters.

#### Results

Volunteers: 43, Total of patients examined: 124, Sex ratio: 0.73, Median age = 32 years old




Figure 2: Patients' distibution by age




Figure 3: Distribution of symptoms in patients




Figure 4: Socioeconomic profile of the patients




Figure 5: Otoscopic examination findings
